In the upcoming Academic year 2021-2022, classes at the Faculty of Law and Administration AMU will take place, according to Rector's Regulation, in three forms:

Option 1) traditional on-campus learning, face-to-face lectures held at the Faculty building. Seminars, language groups and smaller group workshops may take place in the traditional form. *It will be indicated on the plan with black font on white background.*

Option 2) hybrid classes. Lectures will take place in the Faculty building but the streaming will be provided to students who decided to take part online, via MS Teams. Some obligatory lectures, for larger groups, may take place in this form. *It will be indicated on the plan with black font on yellow background.*

Option 3) remote learning. Lectures will take place only via MS Teams or Moodle platform. Some obligatory lectures for large groups or optional lectures may take place in this form. *It will be indicated on the plan with black font on green background.*

The choice of a particular form of classes is made based on AMU internal regulations and depends on the type of classes and a number of participants enrolled for the course. All students will be informed about the sanitary measures in the Faculty buildings. In the due time we will inform you about the form of exams and tests, as well as of the summer semester plans.

Important information:

- Gamma room at the Collegium Iuridicum Novum is open for those students that want to
 follow online classes with their own devices and earphones. This room is open to students
 following different courses at the same time, so while in the room you need to remain silent.
- **Consultations with teachers** will be available online, with some possibilities of setting a face-to-face consultations at the Faculty building.
